



wild2 Projects Limited has its base in the beautiful rural area of Glenlivet. Our residential facility comprises two high standard two bedded units registered by the Care Commission, offering specialist and individualised residential care for young people aged 11-18. Our units are designed for young people who find it difficult to manage well in mainstream or larger units.

It is intended that one unit will provide care for young people who may otherwise be considered for a secure placement and have exhausted local provision. They will probably have:

- been excluded from school
- committed several offences
- misused substances
- a peer group that is unhelpful to them
- be unable to return to their families

In our other unit the skills of our staff team enable us to offer placements to young people who have similar circumstances to those described above but have a learning disability or have been labelled as on the autistic spectrum.

We are also in a position to offer short term care in a crisis.

These two units will offer therapeutic, stable and robust support. We will work in collaboration with all other services and people who are important to meet the child's needs identified in the Care Plan.

wild2 Projects Limited also operates the **IMPACT programme** which makes use of our wonderful natural and neutral learning environment around Glenlivet and the Cairngorm National Park to help young people develop interests and skills in a series of outdoor challenges. Young people in our residential units will have the opportunity to take part in the **IMPACT programme**.

The **IMPACT programme** can also be offered to young people who live with their family but who are struggling to maintain life in the community. Intensive individual and family support is provided as part of this programme.

For young people reaching school leaving age the **wild2work Trust** will help them to access and benefit from training or employment.

All the projects are designed to meet young peoples' needs and equip them with the core skills and behaviours that they need to re-enter education or gain employment. Young people will be subject to a nurturing but rigorous social education programme in order that they can be included in society.

The projects follow a restorative philosophy where young peoples' needs are met whilst they are helped to take responsibility for their actions, set goals and stick to them.
